

APRIL PLANT GUIDE



Brunnera (Perennial forget-me-not): Sky blue bloom, heart-shaped leaves. Sun or shade. 8-12"

Iberis (Candytuft): Tiny white bloom, evergreen ground cover. Sun or shade. Shear back after bloom.



Prunus (Flowering cherry tree): Wow! See it now at old library entrance.

Pulmonaria (Lungwort): Blue blossoms, which change to pink; silver, spotted, pointed green leaves likes shade and good soil.



Fritillaria Persica (Persian lily): Plum colored bells; 30" tall; loves sun

Vinca (Periwinkle): Blue or white blooming, evergreen ground cover. Grown anywhere.



Tulipa (Tulip): Various colors throughout the garden.

Little Gems (Small Bulbs): *Puschkinia* (Striped squill), *Muscari* (Blue grape hyacinth), *Chionodoxa* (Glory of the snow), *Scilla siberica* (Spring beauty)
